

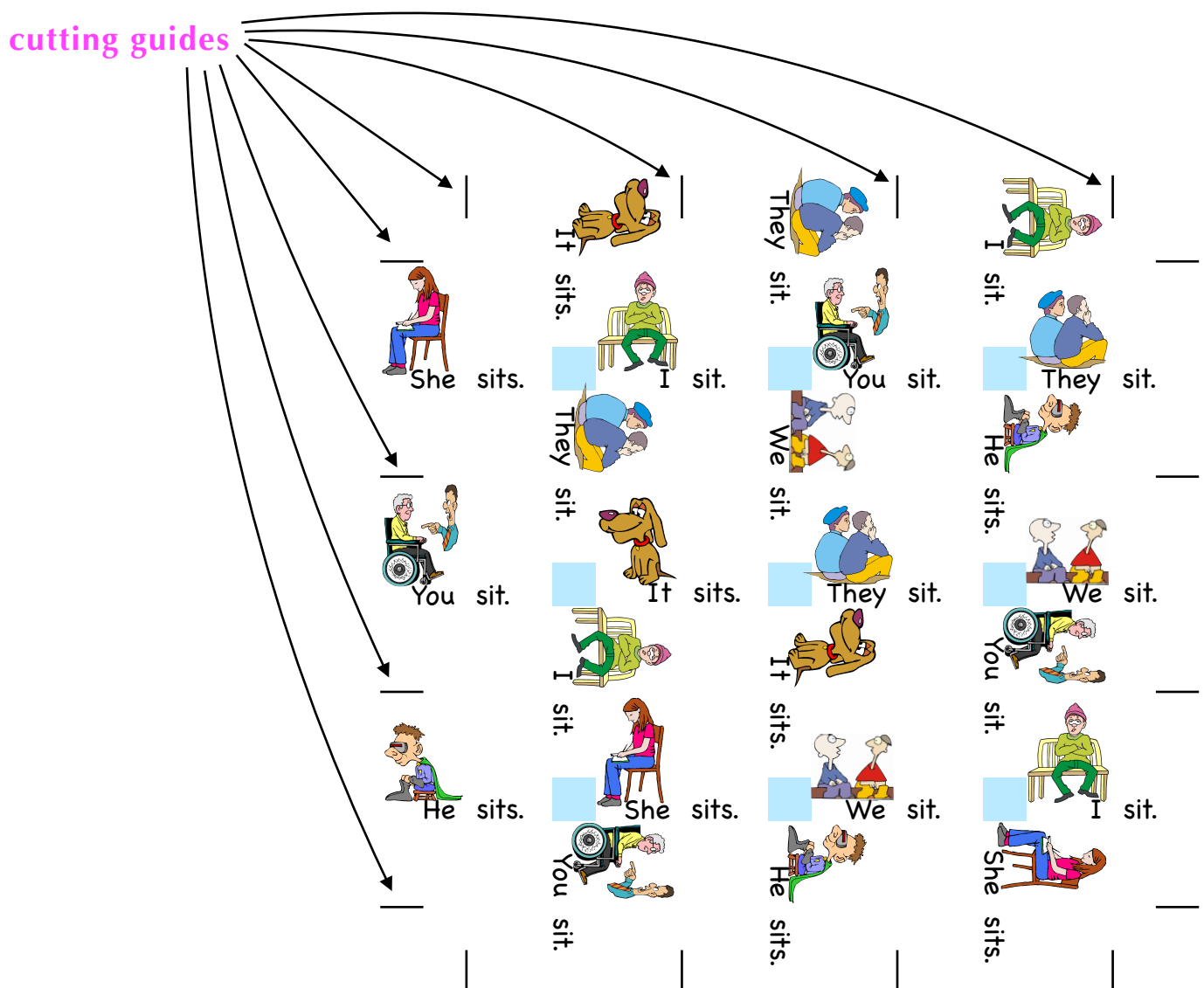
GRAMMAR 9-SQUARE – PDFs TO PRINT

This PDF contains printable pages for making tiles (puzzle pieces) for a puzzle called ... **Grammar 9-Square**.

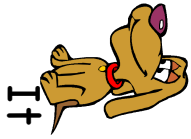
I recommend printing each page on sticky-back paper, then adhering the paper to a thick, stiff paper such as card board, before cutting.

To cut the tiles, simply follow the small black cut guides.
