There are 12 sets of cards here:

eight sets of 2-adjective sequences four sets of 3-adjective sequences


NOTE that there are two sets of each 2-adjective sequence (4 cards per sequence) on a sheet. This is just because there are more cells per page than are needed for the 2-adjective sequences. So the doubles are just extras. Therefore, printing this document (pp. 3~26) will yield two sets of cards for each 2-adjective sequence and one set of cards for each 3-adjective sequence.

The size of the cards (print on A4 paper) should fit 65×95 mm lamination pockets.

Also note that the backs have two different patterns: one for 2-adjective sequences, and one for 3-adjective sequences.

The backs are also color-coded. This makes it much, much easier to find the cards you need for the strips you choose to use each time you play. And later, it makes it much easier to sort the cards out to keep them organized when you finish a game. (Have the students do it with you. It's not only good for you, it's good for them too!)

BE SURE TO FOLLOW THE CUTTING GUIDES—THE SHORT BLACK LINES ALONG THE EDGES OF THE BACK SIDES.
